## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

**Pro-Force 450** is a e-glass matting bound with an emulsion binder that is used to provide reinforcement within the within the **Pro-BW® LO** and **Pro-BW® Plus** systems.

## APPLICATION

**Pro-Force 450** is suitable for use on the following substrates within a **Pro-BW® LO** or **Pro-BW® Plus** system:

- Concrete
- Plywood
- Asphalt
- Bituminous felt
- Single ply membranes

**Pro-Force 450** is suitable for use on the following areas:

- Walkways and balconies
- Protected built-up roof
- Inverted built-up roof
- Warm built-up roof
- Warm deck
- Cold deck

**Note:** Some surfaces may require priming or sacrificial layers.

## INSTALLATION

### Installation Method

- Start the installation with details and verticals, followed by the field areas
- Carefully measure the roof area and assess how many strips of mat are needed
- Carefully remove the mat from the packaging and lay on a clean dry surface, the same way up as it is rolled out
- Roll out the required length, where possible always working with the fall of the roof
- Cut with a straight edge and a very sharp knife, taking care to protect the roof deck below
- Roll the cut piece back up and store until all lengths required have been cut before mixing the resin
- On the prepared and primed surface, embed **Pro-Force 450** into the first coat of Proteus **Pro-BW® LO** or **Pro-BW® Plus**, allowing a minimum of **75mm** for side and end laps
- The matting has one straight cut edge and one feathered edge. Overlap a feathered edge over a straight edge
- Apply extra resin to ensure a closed, pinhole free surface where required
- Allow to cure before applying a second coat of **Pro-BW® LO** or **Pro-BW® Plus** over the whole of the reinforced base coat
