Project Brief

For the internal and external refurbishment of the Grade II Listed Mansion House at Sunbury Court in London, Proteus Waterproofing was appointed to supply a complete roofing system.

Set to house the Salvation Army's international conference and training facilities, and its International College for Officers, the building's dining room also features valuable frescoes painted by Swedish artist Elias Martin (1739-1818) in 1768.

Key Requirement: Seamless Waterproofing

Proteus Waterproofing flat roof overlay systems were selected, as they offer a seamless covering across the entire roof area, including complex detailing, with a 15 year guarantee. Monodex Smooth high performance anti-carbonation protective coating was specified to the parapets and balustrades, in conjunction with Proteus repair mortars.

The project works were installed by Britannia Roofing.
