

The Memorial Hall, Bearsted





Project Overview

Located in the rural village of Bearsted, The Memorial Hall is at the heart of the local community, being used by over 400 people each week.

Proteus Waterproofing® was asked to carry out a survey on the flat roofs to determine their condition. Core samples showed some areas to be saturated with water due to failing membranes and some were suffering from condensation accumulation due to a lack of insulation above the roof deck. Most areas of the roof required complete removal of the existing coverings and replacing with new thermal insulation and waterproofing.

Proteus Waterproofing $^{\circ}$ was asked to formulate a plan which would provide a long-term solution to meet the client's requirements.



Key Challenges & Solutions

• **Budgetary constraints:** A costeffective and durable solution was required by the client for both thermal and waterproofing upgrades. Proteus Waterproofing's technical

team designed a suitable scheme to fit within the specified budget.

• **Fire precautions:** To mitigate the risk of fire, we specified the use of self-adhesive felts from our Proteus Pro-Felt® Endura system.
